
1. NAVSEA 04L provides guidance in the development and distribution of Equipment Facility Requirement (EFR) Plans, reviews EFR Plans when requested and assists in resolving EFR Plan issues. In addition, Mr. Timothy Smith, the NAVSEA representative located at Chief of Naval Education and Training (CNET) Headquarters, is available to assist in the resolution of EFR Plan issues. Two other services currently provided by NAVSEA 04L, assignment of EFR Plan identification numbers and distribution of EFR Plans to the Training Agency (TA) for review and signature, will no longer be performed.

2. References (a) and (b) require Training Support Agencies (TSA) to produce EFR Plans for training programs delivered to Training Agencies (TA). In references (c) and (d) EFR Plans are defined as Program Manager (PM) documents, and the PM is the TSA. As such, EFR Plans are under the purview of the PM.

3. In order to keep the number assigned to the EFR Plan distinct, it is recommended that the number assigned to the EFR by the PM be alphanumeric beginning with PM code, e.g., PMS 610-xxxx. This will prevent duplicate numbers being issued by the numerous PMs and identify ownership of the document to the TA.

4. Enclosure (1) provides instructions for distributing EFR Plans for review and signature by the TA. Chief of Naval Education and Training (CNET), as TA, signs EFR Plans. CNET has assigned EFR Plan signature authority to Logistics Support Managers on the East and West Coasts for schoolhouses under their purview. All EFR Plans must go to the appropriate signature authority who in turn coordinates with the schoolhouses before signing.
